

SUMMARY OF GREENLANDNZ GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSION REPORT

FOR WILD ABOUT WELLINGTON LIMITED



1. INTRODUCTION

Wild About Wellington Limited is a tourism business that specialises in delivering top quality tours of the Capital for small groups. 95% of the tours use only public transport and walking to see the city, making this a low impact and environmentally responsible tourism business. Wild About Wellington operates from the shared premises of its Director, Jennifer Looman.

GreenlandNZ worked with Wild About Wellington to collate 12 months of emissions related activity data and have that data independently verified. The calculated emissions were then offset by retiring verified emission reduction units (VERs).



2. BOUNDARY INFORMATION

This greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions report covers the period from 01 April 2007 to 31 March 2008.

The scope of this report includes:

- Emissions from the core office activities of Wild About Wellington,
- Emissions from client transport activities in vehicles owned, rented or chartered by Wild About Wellington Limited for the purpose of client tours,
- Employee business travel.

Consolidation approach: operational control.

The base year for this report is for the 12 months from 01 April 2007 to 31 March 2008.

3. GHG EMISSION INFORMATION

Greenhouse Gases: Only CO₂ emissions are deemed to be material in the activities of Wild About Wellington i.e. no material volumes of methane, nitrous oxide, hydroflouorocarbons, perflouorocarbons, and sulphur hexafluoride are produced.

3.1 Scope 1 Direct Emissions – Fuel Combustion

Emissions produced by vehicle owned/controlled by Wild About Wellington Limited.

3.2 Scope 2 Indirect Emissions – Purchased Electricity

Electricity purchased and consumed by Wild About Wellington in the provision of tours for clients.

Note: Wild About Wellington Limited operates from shared premises. For the purposes of calculating the emissions from this source using a conservative approach, all of the power consumed on the premises has been allocated to Wild About Wellington.



3.3 Scope 3 Indirect Emissions – Value Chain Emissions

These GHG emissions relate to the activities completed by companies that are not owned or controlled by Wild About Wellington but which are deemed to be significant and directly result from the tours that it provides.

No significant activities have been excluded from the calculation of the GHG emissions produced in the activities of Wild About Wellington. Related activities that have not been included are emissions produced by (i) public transport vehicles used in the provision of tours, and (ii) office waste, due to materiality.

² Certainty Ranking refers to the degree of accuracy intended to be achieved for the actual emissions based on the activity data available and the accuracy of models and/or conversion factors.

4. EMISSIONS AND PERFORMANCE INFORMATION

GHG Management, Reduction Programmes and Targets

Wild About Wellington has committed to a GHG management and target setting programme. The target for the period 01 April 2008 – 31 March 2009 is to keep total GHG emissions under three tonnes while delivering more customer tours than in the prior 12 month period.

Examples of emission reduction activities being implemented include:

- Use of hybrid vehicles for taxi services for staff and clients where possible,
- Use of a courier company with carbon neutral programme for courier and delivery services,
- Continued use and promotion of public transport and walking as key features of the tour experience,
- Re-use, re-cycle programme in office,
- Avoidance of non-essential business travel,
- Energy awareness programme in office and shared premises to minimise unnecessary power usage. This includes the use of a remote real time power meter to allow management to continually monitor power usage.

Assurance Process

The activity values for the actual emissions have been reviewed and verified independently by Kathy Dent, Chartered Accountant of Wellington.



5. OFFSETS

Offsets retired on behalf of Wild About Wellington are from New Zealand Government approved emission reduction projects based in New Zealand.

Offset: three tonnes total, comprising verified CO₂e PRE wind farm units (two tonnes), verified PRE landfill gas capture units (one tonne).

Facilities/operations included in the Inventory:

- Wild About Wellington offices.



6. CERTIFICATION STATUS

Wild About Wellington Limited is a GreenlandNZ Carbon Neutral TotallyCool certified organisation, covering building/office electricity consumption, owned/controlled vehicles, chartered/rented vehicles, and business travel.

Certification valid until: 31 March 2009.
